Registration Now Open! Join us for the osteopathic profession's largest public policy and advocacy event of the year!

The AOA is pleased to host its annual, premier osteopathic advocacy event -- DO Day - Distinctive in Healthcare Advocacy and Leadership -- offering both virtual leadership training and professional development CME sessions for physicians, affiliate leaders and students, and in-person advocacy opportunities to educate lawmakers on osteopathic physician and student issues.

This conference provides two opportunities to participate -- the virtual CME sessions on Saturday, April 13, and Sunday, April 14, and in-person briefing sessions and Congressional meetings on Wednesday, April 17 and Thursday, April 18, in Washington, DC. Attendees can sign up for either or both options.

The virtual conference content will be available through June 14 to provide you with the flexibility you need to watch the sessions at your convenience.

Attendees registering for the in-person Congressional meetings will be organized into small groups based on their home address and scheduled for three to six meetings with their U.S. Senate offices and members of the House of Representatives. Participation in Congressional meetings are capped for each state, so you are encouraged to register early to secure a spot.

Registration limits for each state are based on the size of the state's Congressional delegation and state osteopathic association, with space reserved in each state delegation for physicians and students. Cultivating strong osteopathic advocates and facilitating meaningful relationships with lawmakers to help advance health policy is central to the AOA's mission, and DO Day is the perfect opportunity to do so.
